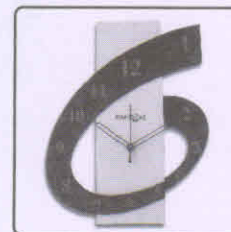

## Admission Formalities

1. Nursery, L.K.G., U.K.G. and class 1st must produce evidence of their date of birth by obtaining certificate from Municipal/Hospital/Village Panchayat record.
2. Students going to school for the first time will be tested orally.
3. No Student will admitted without a transfer certificate from the last school attend.
4. After registration the child can appear in the entrance test conducted for class IInd and above, but the school reserves the right to refuse admission to any applicant without furnishing.

## Admission Test

The admission test will cover, Hindi, Maths, Science based on the syllabus of the preceding class to which admission is sought.

## The Criteria for Admission 2020-21

- 1 Notification on registration shall be made in advance and the prospectus registration from the school office during the prescribed hours.
- 2 Admission forms are available on the school upto 2 Feb 2020.
- 3 Admission forms are to be filled and submitted at the same time of registration.
- 4 The name in the final list will only be admitted in the school.
- 5 The academic year of school is from April to March.
- 6 Registration fee Rs. 1000/- is not refundable.

**Registration does not guarantee admission. It will be subject to merit and availability of seats**

- 7 Duly filled registration forms will be accepted in the school office during the dates.

### **Requirements for registration**

- 7 Date of Birth certificate from the competent authority such as Panchayat, Mahanagar palika, Nagarpalika, Govt. Hospital. No other certificate from whatever source it be, will not be accepted.
- 8 Date of birth once given shall not be changed on any account whatsoever.
- 9 Stamp-size photograph shall have completed 3 1/2 by March 31st of the year of admission.

### **Interaction**

- 10 An interaction with the child registered for admission shall be held in order to assess the ability of speaking of answering the questions asked.
- 11 Children brought to interaction must be accompanied by the parents.
- 12 The interest and the availability of parents in helping the child will be specially counted in the selection of children for admission.
- 13 Children brought for interaction shall be able to.
  - b Recognize and recite English Alphabets.
  - b Recognize and recite Hindi Alphabets.
  - b Recognize and count Number 1 to 20
  - b Recognize Colours, Flowers, Animals, Birds and Fruits.
  - b Answer questions smartly and intelligently.



## **Requirement for Registration other than LKG**

- 1 Transfer Certificate from the school last attended.
- 2 Original Mark List (Report Card).
- 3 Written test and interaction will be held. Admission will be taken on the basis of merit and availability of seats.
- 4 The presence of the parents of the students to be admitted is compulsory.

### **General Rules**

- 5 Student must be regular and punctual in attendance. No leave of absence is granted except on written application from the parent or guardian stating specific reasons for the same.
- 6 Fees are payable in advances of every two months. It must be cleared by the 10th of the month. If fees remain unpaid the pupil's name will be struck off the rolls and re-admission will have to be made in the following month on payment or re-admission and the fine. Fine will be 50 after the due date.
- 7 Student will not be allowed to leave the school during the school hours. So parents are kindly advised not to come with such requests. If anyone other than the parent is coming to take the student, he/she must produce a request letter from the parent in writing.
- 8 All school and office works will be attended during only 8:00 am to 2:00 pm.
- 9 Parents are not allowed to go to the classes.
- 10 No students are allowed to bring Mobile phones, Camera, Radio or any other Electronic Gadgets to the school without prior permission from the Principal.
- 11 English is the medium of communication in the school premises. Speak only English during school hours.

### **Recommendations to the Parents**

- 1 Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities by ensuring that the children observe punctuality and discipline, prepare their lessons and take an active part in the activities of the school.
- 2 Private Tuition is not encouraged. Instead, the parents are requested to give personal attention to the children and help them in their doubts as far as possible.

- 3 Parents/Guardians are requested to be in constant touch with the school to have a clear knowledge of the ward's progress in studies. They must by all means attend the Parent-Teachers Meetings to consult with the teachers in the classroom or in the staff room, without the permission of the Principal. Those who wish to make any not the class teachers.
- 4 When students is likely to absent owing to illness for a longs for a long period, the Principal must be informed through an application for leave supported by medical Certificate within a week, failure to do so will result in the children's name being removed from the school roll.
- 5 The Principal or teacher may punish a pupil for habitual idleness, disobedience or misconduct, indiscipline, not preparing the lesson etc. by suspension or removal without assigning any reason for the action.
- 6 The School authorities are not responsible for the safety of a student after the school hours. Necessary arrangement must therefore be made to take the children home immediately after the class.
- 7 The school accepts no responsibility if through failure in wearing school uniform, in bringing books to class, in getting the signature of the parents on remarks written by teachers or on the absence record in the Hand Book or in not paying the fees in time, the students is obliged to return home during class hours.
- 8 No. School Business be Transacted During The Holidays or outside the school hours.
- 9 The one who sign in the admission form of the student will be responsible for the students and is supposed to contact the school for the parent-teacher meeting or any other purpose. If the student does not reside with the parents, parents will have to introduce the guardian or the persons incharges to the Principal. The school will not accept any other person to represent the guardian.
- 10 Vehicles of every sort, including bicycles, taking children to and from the school are not permitted inside the school compound, They shall stop at the gate. The instruction given in this prospectus is liable to change without notice. Any such changes, when made will be binding on all existing student also.
- 11 Parents should check the school calender regularly and sign any reports recorded by the teachers and the assignments and home work given.
- 12 Parents are not allowed to interview the teachers in the classroom or in the staffroom, without the permission of the principal. Those who wish to make any complaint about their children's education or other matters should do so to the principal/co-ordinator and not to the class teachers.
